## Re: Year 10 Personal Development Week

I am writing to inform you that Thursday 13 to Wednesday 19 July 2023 is Personal Development week at South Hunsley. As you are aware, personal development is an integral part of a student's school experience. These days will include activities in school linked to personal development topics, as well as offering a range of extra-curricular activities and visits.

The week is compulsory for students to attend. The activities provided will allow students to develop the knowledge, skills and attributes that they need to manage their lives now and in the future. These skills and attributes help students stay healthy, safe and prepare them for life and work. It can help students achieve their academic potential, and leave school equipped with skills they need.
