Maths

The maths curriculum is currently covering shape and angles – Year 9 unit 6. Our Limitless Potential pages have links to Hegarty Maths and Corbett Maths resources that cover all of these areas. Students should access the Maths section of the Year 9 page on our school website and complete the videos and tasks for the most recent topic area they have covered in their maths lessons below. Science

Students are working on different topics in their science lessons. In Biology, we are looking at the Human Biology unit. In Chemistry, classwork is currently looking at rates of chemical reactions.
