Payment

The passport will need at least 6 months remaining when we visit Iceland. If you check your child's passport and it expires before August 2024, then it will need to be renewed prior to travel.

Equipment

- Clothes for evenings (jeans are fine)
- Swimming costume (for the blue lagoon)
